

Flagger Certification

Objective:

The Flagging Certification class teaches students how to protect fellow construction workers, motorists and pedestrians by safely directing vehicle operators through traffic controlled construction zones. (2.5 hours)

Course Information:

The flagging course is a combination of lecture, visual presentations, outdoor exercises and a final test.

Topics Covered:

- Review of Virginia standards

- Guidelines and safety procedures

- Traffic control principals

- Demonstration of various flagging tools and techniques

Upon completion of the Flagging Certification class, the student should recognize the specific equipment when performing flagging responsibilities. Correctly execute the basic Stop/Proceed/Slow directions and set up a flagger station in such a way as to maximize their own safety and the safety of the crew and road users.
